A Job Preparation Workshop – Friday March 26th and Saturday March 27th – is also included in the program.

The TESL program will be held weekends (Friday, 6-10 pm, Saturday and Sunday, 9 am-6 pm) at our Progress campus, followed by observation and practicum (see dates above).

Successful completion of TESL Part One and Part Two allows the student to teach English as a Second Language within Ontario.

Admission Requirements for the program include:

- university degree
- fluent English skills and acceptable responses on the application form.
- for applicants who have completed their degree in a country where the official language is not English, a TOEFL iBT score of 103 or TOEFL CBT score of 250 is required or an IELTS score of 7.5 with no score lower than 7 and an oral score of 8 or other proficiency tests recognized by TESL Ontario (<http://teslontario.org>).

Costs for the program (including the Job Preparation Workshop):

- TESL Part One \$1,700 per person plus books. Payment deadline Sept. 19th, 2009
- TESL Part Two \$2,125 per person plus books. Payment deadline Dec. 14th, 2009

\*Participants must register and pay in full for TESL Part One or pay in full for TESL Part One and Part Two. Full payment for TESL Part Two may be accepted upon completion of TESL Part One.
