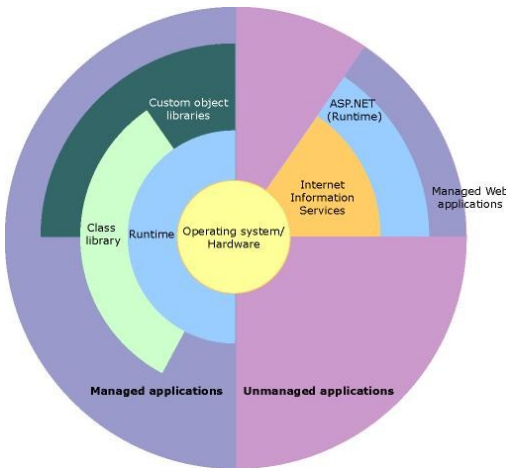

MICROSOFT .NET (7030)

The certification will provide a significant competitive advantage in the job market where this credential is widely recognized and respected.

You will also receive course preparation for Microsoft Certification exams that offer several levels of certification in the .NET development framework including:

- Windows Applications (CEDN 001, 002, 004) Exam Code 98-361
- Web Applications (CEDN 001, 003, 004) Exam Code 98-362
- SQL Server (COMP 122, CEDN 006) Exam Code 98-363

You may complete either COMP-100 Programming 1 (Introductory Programming Concepts) or CEDN-001 (Introduction to .NET Programming with VB.NET) as the required introductory programming course before moving on to the more advanced courses in the certification.

Students may wish to take [CEDN-007](#) SQL Server 2008 Administration & Reports as a compliment to the required courses listed below.
