# Licence Training

## MOTORCYCLE RIDER TRAINING

Learn to ride safely in this 22-hour Canada Safety Council-approved motorcycle rider training course. This course is offered to riders who would like to get their M2 Licence. The course is a combination of theory (three hours in-class instruction) and practical riding (you will have the use of a motorcycle during this portion of the course coupled with closely supervised instruction).

In order to participate and enrol in this course, you must:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Possess, and have available, a valid Ontario Ministry of Transportation class M1 permit
- Come to class with the following mandatory\* basic riding gear, including: DOT-approved motorcycle helmet, a heavy long-sleeved jacket – leather or denim (preferred), blue jeans or heavy slacks, full-fingered leather gloves, heavy duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g. leather cowboy boots, work boots)

**\* Anyone dressed inappropriately will not be allowed to ride**

**Our certified instructors will provide training covering the following:**

Motorcycle safety & general theory, balancing, cold starting, braking, stopping, gear changing, shoulder checking, slow riding and pattern riding, traffic behaviours, collision avoidance and so much more.

# M2 Exit Training

## Training leading to your full “M” Licence

### M2 EXIT

CEMO-805

\$445 (includes tax)

This course is designed for experienced street riders who want to make the most of their riding skills and be tested for the M licence. The course consists of three hours of classroom theory followed by eight hours of practical riding.

Practical training segment includes:

- Road management skills
- Intersections
- Left and right turns
- Lane changes
- Roadside stops and expressway riding
- Upon completion of the practical training students will be given the M2 Exit road test by MTO-certified instructors

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- Participants must provide a motorcycle/scooter capable of reaching highway speeds. You may also use a rental, providing it is street legal
- Proof of ownership
- Insurance certificate
- A valid M2 licence for a minimum of 22 months, or a minimum of 18 months provided you have passed a recognized motorcycle rider training program
- DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- A heavy long-sleeved jacket – leather or denim preferred



- Blue jeans or heavy slacks
- Full-fingered leather gloves
- Heavy duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g. leather cowboy boots, work boots)

All courses are held Friday 7:00-9:30 pm, Saturday 8 am-6 pm, and Sunday – M2 Exit Road Test appointment TBA.

# Other Training Courses Offered

## GEARING UP MOTORCYCLE RIDER REFRESHER

CEMO-804

\$264

This eight-hour Canada Safety Council refresher course is designed for experienced motorcycle riders with a valid M2 or M licence.

The course is made up of two hours of classroom theory and six hours of practical riding. It is mandatory for students to demonstrate entry-level riding ability by passing the MOST II test at the beginning of the course.

Practical riding exercises include: slow speed manoeuvres, push steering, emergency braking, emergency swerving, and collision avoidance.



## APPLICANTS MUST

- Provide own licensed motorcycle and insurance certificate. Bike rentals are available on request \$100 plus \$150 refundable security deposit

- Possess a valid Ontario Ministry of Transportation class M2 or M permit

## INTRODUCTION TO MOTORCYCLING

CEMO-808

\$78 (includes tax)

This three-hour course is for those who want to get a jump start on the full basic rider course; for anyone considering riding a motorcycle but wants to attempt it before they make a major purchase, or for someone just interested in getting a preview of what all the hype is about.

This session will introduce the rider to:

- Proper balance
- Riding at a controlled pace
- M1 not required
- Starting and stopping
- Gears and safety

NOTE: This course is not intended to take the place of the full Motorcycle Rider course.

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- Must have a DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- DOT-approved motorcycle helmet Must wear a heavy long-sleeved jacket (non-synthetic), jeans or heavy slacks, full-fingered leather gloves and heavy-duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g., leather cowboy boots, work boots)

## MOTORCYCLE SKILL ENHANCEMENT **NEW**

\$360 (includes tax)

This course is designed for riders who wish to enhance their street riding skills. It also appeals to those who completed the M1 motorcycle course, purchased a motorcycle, and now wish to practice their skills on their own motorcycle. The course consists of three hours of classroom theory followed by six hours of coaching by certified motorcycle instructors. (Note: This course is conducted on public roads and highways.)

Practical training segment includes, slow speed maneuvers, road management skills and street proofing, intersections, curves riding techniques, collision avoidance and Emergency braking, rural and expressway riding.

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- Must provide own street legal scooter/motorcycle (over 50cc) licenced, proof of ownership and Liability Insurance Certificate
- Must possess a valid M2 licence or M2L or a M Licence.
- Must have a DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- Must wear a heavy long-sleeved jacket (non-synthetic), jeans or heavy slacks, full-fingered leather gloves and heavy-duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g., leather cowboy boots, work boots)
- Must attend all classes of the section you are registered for in their entirety (no exceptions)
- Eye protection is strongly recommended

## SCOOTER TRAINING

CEMO-809

\$365 (includes tax)

This Canada Safety Council: Scooter Gearing Up course is designed to equip the new rider with the necessary skills to ride confidently and safely on a limited-speed motorcycle (LSM). This course is designed for anyone who wants to ride a 50cc or smaller scooter and is completely suitable for individuals with limited or no riding experience. An M2L test will be taken on-site at the end of the course.

When you successfully complete the Ministry M2L test, you will receive a graduation card (some insurance companies may offer a premium discount on presentation of the certificate).

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Students must possess and have available a valid Ontario Ministry of Transportation class M1 Permit.

- DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- Blue jeans or heavy slacks
- A heavy long-sleeved jacket – leather or denim
- Full-fingered leather gloves
- Heavy duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g. leather cowboy boots or work boots)

This Canada Safety Council Scooter course is designed for experienced street riders who want to make the most of their riding skills and be tested for the LSM licence. The course consists of three hours classroom theory followed by 6 hours practical riding. Practical training segments includes road management skills, intersections, left and right turns, lane changes, roadside stops and group riding. Upon completion of the practical training, students will be given the LSM Exit road test given by our MTO-certified instructors. Course runs rain or shine.

### MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- Must provide own street legal scooter licence, proof of ownership and Liability Insurance Certificate
- Must possess a valid M2 licence or M2L for a minimum of 22 months, or a minimum of 18 months provided you have passed a recognized Motorcycle Rider Training program or scooter training
- Must have a DOT approved motorcycle helmet
- Must wear a heavy long-sleeved jacket (non-synthetic), jeans or heavy slacks, full-fingered leather gloves and heavy-duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g., leather cowboy boots, work boots)
- Must attend all classes of the section you are registered for in their entirety (no exceptions)
- Eye protection is strongly recommended
