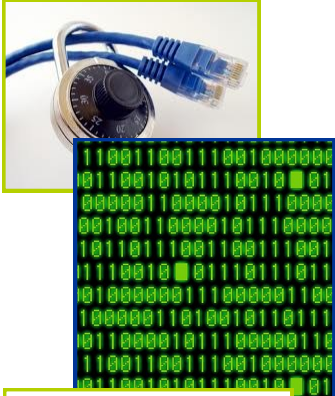




# Network Security Administrator Certificate Program
