

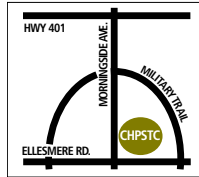

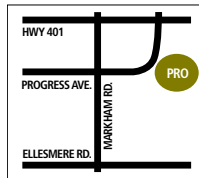

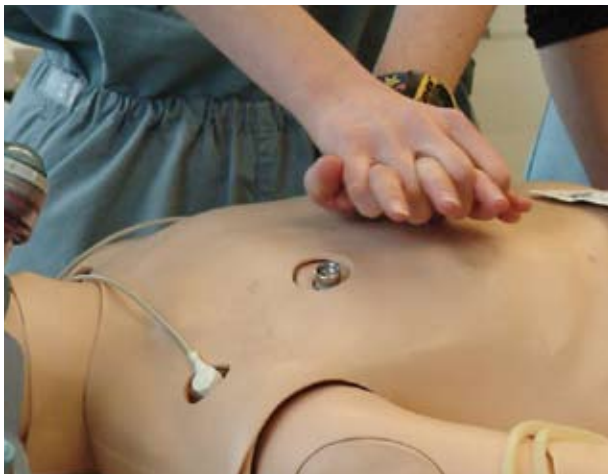
Assessment and evaluation is through hands-on practice during practical scenarios, individual review and a written/oral theory exam. There is a great deal of physical activity; please wear comfortable, casual clothing. Please check with your doctor if you have any health problems that may limit your activity.

STANDARD FIRST AID (SFA) INCLUDING CPR/AED LEVEL C OR HCP CCPR-101

This two-day session is for the person who requires a comprehensive course in basic first aid and CPR/AED. Learn a variety of topics such as: how to respond to emergencies, CPR Level C or HCP, prevention of disease transmission, respiratory and cardiac arrest, injuries to the head and spine; bone, muscle and joint injuries; wound care; and how to deal with sudden medical conditions and environmental emergencies. **This course has been extended to include CPR and AED certification, and provides you with a three (3)-year certification.** Please let your instructor know at the beginning if you are working towards CPR/AED level C or HCP.

\$110 Saturdays and Sundays 9am-6pm (15 hours)

CPR/AED LEVEL HCP, BLS-HCP CCPR-102

This one-day course is intended for physicians, nurses, paramedics and allied health care providers (i.e., RTs, OTs, PTs) whose certification has expired beyond the 12-month recommended period. It covers: adult/child/baby CPR - one and two-person rescuer; adult/child/baby choking; pulse check BVM; rescue breathing; AED certification; barrier devices, and disease prevention. Certification level is CPR/AED level HCP, in accordance with ILCOR (International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation) guidelines.

\$55 Saturdays, 9am-3pm, (6 hours)

CPR/AED LEVEL C RECERTIFICATION, BLS-REC CCPR-103

This course is intended for people who hold a current CPR level C. Certification level is CPR/AED level C in accordance with ILCOR (International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation) standards.

\$40 Saturdays, 9am-1pm (4 hours)

CPR/AED LEVEL C, BLS-C CCPR-104

This course is intended for police, firefighters, first responders, workplace response teams and lifeguards whose certification has expired beyond the 12-month recommended period. It covers the following: adult/child/baby CPR - one-person rescuer; adult/child/baby choking; AED certification; disease prevention; barrier devices; and may include adult/child CPR - two-person rescuer (30:2 ratio only). Certification level is CPR/AED Level C in accordance with ILCOR (International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation) standards.
