## Canadian Securities Course – Parts 1 & 2

The Canadian Securities Course is the compulsory licensing for individuals wishing to work in the financial services industry as mutual fund salespersons or to trade stocks, bonds and other investment securities. These courses prepare individuals to become qualified professional financial planners as well as those who simply want a better understanding of the complex financial world around them.

### CANADIAN SECURITIES COURSE - PART 1 CCSC-101

This in-class preparation course covers the material contained in exam #1 of the Canadian Securities Course, offered by the Canadian Securities Institute. This course reviews the investment market in Canada and distinguishes the roles and responsibilities of the key players in the financial industry. You will examine the nature of assets, client needs assessment, various investment products available to the public, risks associated with investments, portfolio evaluation and the analysis of publicly-traded company financial statements.

### CANADIAN SECURITIES COURSE - PART 2 CCSC-102

This in-class preparation course covers the material contained in exam #2 of the Canadian Securities Course, offered by the Canadian Securities Institute.

This course will review financial planning of individual portfolios and the taxation of various types of investment income. Individuals will also analyze the markets as they pertain to the various business cycles and investment products; and be introduced to designing and managing investment portfolios while maintaining client relationships.
