Licence Training

CLASS M2 LICENCE TRAINING

Learn to ride safely in this 22-hour Canada Safety Council-approved motorcycle rider training course. This course is offered for riders who would like to get their M2 Licence. The course is a combination of theory (three hours in-class instruction) and practical riding (you will have the use of a motorcycle during this portion of the course coupled with closely supervised instruction).

In order to participate and enrol in this course, you must:

- be 16 years of age or older
- possess, and have available, a valid Ontario Ministry of Transportation class M1 permit
- come to class with the following mandatory* basic riding gear, including: DOT-approved motorcycle helmet; a heavy long-sleeved jacket – leather or denim (preferred); blue jeans or heavy slacks; full-fingered leather gloves; heavy duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g. leather cowboy boots, work boots).

* Anyone dressed inappropriately will not be allowed to ride

Our certified instructors will provide training covering the following:

Motorcycle safety & general theory, balancing, cold starting, braking, stopping, gear changing, shoulder checking, slow riding and pattern riding, traffic behaviours, collision avoidance and so much more.

We provide:

- Certified and experienced instruction
- Motorcycles for duration of the course
- Student kits containing:
 - Canada Safety Council's Motorcycle Rider's Manual
 - Helmet decal and pin
 - A graduation card upon successful course completion (some insurance companies will frequently offer premium discounts on presentation of this card)

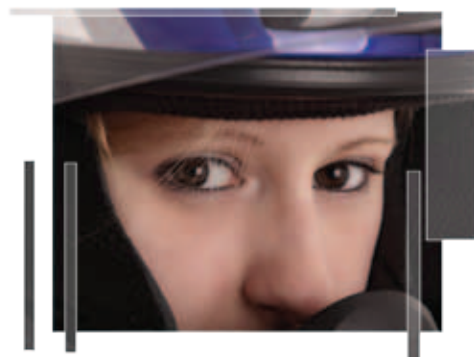

Training leading to your full "M" Licence

M2 EXIT

\$410 (includes GST)

CEMO-805

This course is designed for experienced street riders who want to make the most of their riding skills and be tested for the M licence. The course consists of three hours of classroom theory followed by eight hours of practical riding.

Practical training segment includes:

- road management skills
- intersections
- left and right turns
- lane changes
- roadside stops and expressway riding

Upon completion of the practical training students will be given the M2 Exit road test by MTO-certified instructors.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

- Participants must provide a motorcycle/scooter capable of reaching highway speeds. You may also use a rental, providing it is street legal
- Proof of ownership
- Insurance certificate
- A valid M2 licence for a minimum of 22 months, or a minimum of 18 months provided you have passed a recognized motorcycle rider training program
- DOT-approved motorcycle helmet
- A heavy long-sleeved jacket – leather or denim preferred
- Blue jeans or heavy slacks
- Full-fingered leather gloves
- Heavy duty leather boots that have a heel and cover the ankle (e.g. leather cowboy boots, work boots)
